to beg for a soda. He will only buy water for me. I'm not allowed to have anything. My mom has tried to help with shampoo and stuff. The little money I get from babysitting I use for toothpaste and body wash. I moved into a spare bedroom a year ago. Now he won't pay for my doctor visits and leaves my medications at the pharmacy for weeks at a time. I have asthma, high blood

pressure and a blood disorder. I need those medications. I'm scared he will hurt me if I try to go to the bank for money. Is this abuse? -- Help Me, Please Dear Help: Yes, this is abuse. Your husband doesn't have to hit you to be an abuser. Controlling all the money, as well as access to your medications and doctors, is also a form of abuse. The bride was one of her closest friends growing up, and I always thought of her as a second daughter. My husband and I looked at her registry and purchased expensive china for her that cost us hundreds of dollars. We just received her thank-you note in the mail. It was a postcard with a short
